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A MESSAGE FROM THE HEART!

This is my message to you, because I love you ..

Who are you? Why were you created? And what happen after death?

How do you become worthy to enter Paradise?

And what is the path that leads to Paradise to be immortal and never die?

WHO ARE YOU?

You are a human being whom Allah has honored you with a mind capable of distinguishing

between what brings benefits and harms to you.

You are a human being whom Allah has conferred preference over other creatures.

You are a human being whom Allah has dignified by virtue of sending His Messengers to guide

you to the right path.

You are a human being whom Allah has valued greatly, has ennobled and has harnessed other

creature to be at your service, such as animals, birds, plants, seas, fish, and others.

WHY DID ALLAH CREATE YOU?

Allah created you to worship and obey Him. You cannot know how to worship Allah except through the honorable Messengers sent by Allah to mankind to guide them to follow what Allah loves and wants and to abandon what Allah hates.

Allah created Adam, peace be upon him, and human beings remained on the true monotheism and they worshiped Allah for a period of ten centuries. After that, people began to relinquish the worship of Allah with a sharp eye directed to worship idols. However, Allah sent to them the Prophet of Noah, to return them to the worship of Allah alone and to abandon the worship of idols. After years of divine call to monotheism, few people believed in the call of Prophet of Noah and so many arrogantly disbelieved the call. Thus, Allah drowned those disbelievers to death by almighty Flood.

As such, whenever people went astray from worshiping Allah, Allah sent to them a Messenger to guide them to the obedience of Allah. Thus, Allah sent to humanity Prophet Moses, Jesus and then Muhammad, may Allah's prayers and peace be upon them.

ALLAH STRENGTHEN EVERY PROPHET WITH MIRACLES.

One of the miracles of the Prophet of Allah, Moses, peace be upon him, was his stick. His stick was to turn into a great snake once thrown on the ground. Furthermore, Moses stroke the sea with his stick, so it was divided, and each separate part became like the huge, firm mass of a mountain, and there was, between them, a great road through which Moses and his people passed. When Pharaoh and soldiers wanted to follow Moses and passed through this great road, Allah ordered the sea to return to its previous state and drowned Pharaoh and his soldiers to death.

In addition, the miracles given by Allah to prophet Jesus peace be upon himto strength him through hiscall was that prophet Jesuspeace be upon him formed clay into the figure of a bird and breathed into it, causing it to thereby become a living bird by Allah's leave; he healed those who born blind and the lepers, and he revived the dead by Allah's leave.

Among the miracles given by Allah to his Prophet Muhammad, peace be upon him, were that the infidels of Quraysh told him: We want a miracle to prove that you are a messenger from Allah. Then, Prophet Muhammad, peace be upon him, looked at the moon and called his Lord, and said to the moon: "split by Allah's leave", and the moon miraculously split in two halves; one half went behind the mountain and then the two halves joined together again to their natural state. They said after seeing this miraculous event: We should not respond to your call now until we ask people in other places whether they actually saw this miracle or you bewitched our eyes! When the merchants of Quraysh who were in the Levant came back to Mecca, they told them that they had seen the moon split in two halves on that night.

Another miracle given exclusively to the Prophet Muhammad, peace be upon him, was the Holy Quran. The Quran is filled with numerous types of miracles.

1. The Rhetorical Miracle of Language:

The Quran was revealed to people who were at their peak in eloquence and rhetoric. Then, the Quran challenged them to come up with a single chapter equal in eloquence and rhetoric like the ones in the Holy Quran. After trying feverishly, they failed and could not respond to the challenge.

2. Scientific Miracle:

The Quran mentioned scientific facts that human beings have never known except in the modern era. Thus, they are overwhelmed with great shock and surprise after realizing that they are already mentioned in the Quran, which made many non-Muslim scholars announce their conversion tolslam, for example: It is the Muslim Prof. Abdul Majeed Al-Zindani who conducted a discussion with Prof. TajatTagasun, head of the Anatomy and Embryology Department at Chiang Mai University in Thailand, who then became the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine.

The Muslim Prof. Abdul Majeed Al-Zindani asked Prof. TajatTagasun: Where do the receptors responsible for the feeling with pain exist in the human body?

Prof. TajatTagasun replied: They exist in the nerve endings in the skin. Thus, if the skin is completely burned, the sensitive nerves are destroyed, then no pain after that will be felt by a person. Therefore, there must be a skin to feel with pain.

The Muslim Prof. Abdul Majeed Al-Zindani asked Prof. TajatTagasun: When have scientists reached for this discovery?

Prof. TajatTagasun replied: Very soon after the invention of modern equipment.

The Muslim Prof. Abdul Majeed Al-Zindani said: But the Quran told us about it from more than 1400 years ago.

Prof. TajatTagasun surprisingly replied: It is unreasonable! Bring the Quran and prove it.

He brought the Quran, and opened Chapter: al-Nisaa, verse (56) and read:

"Those who reject our Signs, We shall soon cast into the Fire: as often as their skins are roasted through, We shall change them for fresh skins, that they may taste the penalty: for Allah is Exalted in Power, Wise."

In other words, Allah will torment the disbelievers with fire on the Day of Judgment. Once their skins are burned, the pain will stop. Therefore, Allah will create other skins for them to continue feeling with pain.

The Muslim Prof. Abdul Majeed Al-Zindani asked Prof. TajatTagasun: Could it be that Muhammad received this information from a human source?

Prof. TajatTagasun replied: It is impossible! Humanity at the time did not know anything about it. Where did he get it from?

The Muslim Prof. Abdul Majeed Al-Zindani said: From Allah; because Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah.

Prof. TajatTagasun said: Let me study the Quran in a modern scientific study.

SURPRISE

After a full year of studying the Holy Quran in the light of modern science, Professor TajatTagasun came to attend the 8th Medical Conference in Saudi Arabia. In the Torah in Deuteronomy, Chapter 33, Paragraph 2:

He said, "The Lord came from Sinai, And rose from Seir to them. He shone forth from Mount Paran."

The meaning of this paragraph:

"The Lord came from Sinai": This refers to the revelation of the Torah to the Prophet Moses, peace and blessings be upon him, on Mount Sinai in Sinai.

"And rose from Seir to them": This refers to the place where Prophet Jesus, peace and blessings be upon him, lived. Seir refers to the series of the mountains of Seir, which extends on the eastern side of Wadi Araba in Palestine.

"He shone forth from Mount Paran": Paran is the ancient name of the land of Mecca where the Prophet Muhammad, peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, was born and received Allah's revelation.

The Torah, the Song of Songs, Chapter 5, Paragraph 16 in Hebrew:

"חִבּּוֹ מֵמְתַלֶּים וְכֵלָוֹ מַחֲמַדֶּים גֶזה דוֹדִי וְזָה רֵעִי בְּנָוֹת יְרוּשָׁלָם"

The meaning of this paragraph:

His mouth is sweetness itself; he is Muhammad. This is my beloved, this is my friend, daughters

of Jerusalem.

THE GOSPEL FORETELLS THE PROPHET OF ALLAH MUHAMMAD, PEACE BE UPON HIM

1. The Gospel of John, Chapter 16, Paragraph (7): Jesus Christ, peace be upon him, says, addressing his companions:

"But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the paracletus will not come to you."

The paracletus is a Greek word which means Muhammad.

2. The Book of Isaiah, Chapter 21, Paragraph (13.14):

"Oracle: in the steppe: In the thicket in the steppe you will spend the night, caravans of

Dedanites."

This is a statement that the revelation would be revealed to the Messenger of the Arabs, Muhammad, peace be upon him, and that he would pass on his journey from Mecca to Medina by the region of (Dedan) which is near the City of the Prophet "Medina". There are many good omens in the Bible of the coming of the Prophet Muhammad peace be

upon him.

THE WAY TO PARADISE!

Do you want to enter Paradise, where you live forever and never die?

How do you embrace Islam?

Q 1: What should be done to embrace Islam?

A 1: You should say: I bear witness that there is none worthy of worship except Allah and

Muhammed is His Messenger.

Q 2: After saying that does one become a Muslim?

A 2: Yes!

Q 3: What does Islam testimony of faith mean?

A 3: It means: I believe that Allah is One; He is the Creator, the Provider, the Giver of Life and

the Giver of Death, and that none is worthy of worship except Allah.

Hereby, I will worship Allah alone, and I will worship none except Him. I believe in all the

Messengers and Prophets, including the Seal of the Prophets, Muhammad peace be upon him.

WELCOME TO ISLAM

Congratulations to everyone who has embraced Islam so far. All of your sins have been forgiven

because the Messenger of Islam, Muhammad peace be upon him, says: (Islam effaces previous

misdeeds).

In other words, whoever embracethe religion of Islam, has all of his/her past misdeeds and sins

forgiven and starts a new age with new white paper that should be filled with good deeds,

avoiding any of the misdeeds.

WHAT ARE THE PILLARS OF ISLAM?

The pillars of Islam are five:

The First Pillar: It is the testimony of faith that that there is none worthy of worship except Allah and Muhammed is His Messenger.

The Second Pillar: It is performing your prayers 5 times daily.

The Third Pillar: It is the payment of Zakat. If your money which you save or trade amounts for 600 grams of silver, you have to pay 2.5% for the poor and the needy, preferably your relatives.

The Fourth Pillar: It is to fast Ramadan. If the month of Ramadan starts, then you have to refrain from eating, drinking and having sexual intercourse with your wife from dawn to sunset only. But after Maghrib until dawn, you are allowed to eat and have sexual intercourse with your wife if you wish. However, if you are sick and cannot fast, you can feed a poor person for every day during the Holy month.

The Fifth Pillar: It is the pilgrimage to the Holy House of Allah in Mecca once in a lifetime. However, if you cannot afford to perform your pilgrimage, you are not obliged to perform it.

How to Perform your Ritual Ablution?

If you want to pray, you have to comply with these steps:

First: Perform your Ritual Ablution:

These points explain how to perform your ritual ablution:

1. Wash your hands. Use your left hand to wash your right hand. Do this three times.

2. Take water into your mouth. Use your right hand to rinse water into your mouth three times.

3. Inhale water into your nose. Use your right hand to rinse water and inhale it into your nose three times.

4. Wash your face. Wash your face three times by spreading your hands from your right ear to the left, and from the hairline to the chin.

5. Wash your lower arms from wrists to elbows, leaving no part dry. From your wrist to your elbow, wash your right arm with your left hand three times.

6. Wash your lower arms from wrists to elbows, leaving no part dry. From your wrist to your elbow, wash your left arm with your right hand three times.

7. Clean your head. This is known as "masah". Using your wet hands, gently wipe the entire head once, from the forehead to the back of the head.

8. Wipe your ears inside and out. With the same water, use your finger to clean all the crevices of your ear. Use your thumb to clean behind your ears from the bottom upward. This is also done one time.

9. Wash your right feet. Clean up to the ankles and be sure water goes between the toes three times.

10. Wash your left feet. Clean up to the ankles and be sure water goes between the toes three times.

<u>Then say</u>: I bear witness that there is none worthy of worship except Allah and Muhammed is His Messenger and His Slave.

HOW TO PRAY?

 Stand upright facing the direction of Al-Ka'bah. This position is called Qiyaam and the direction is called Qiblah in Arabic. Raise your hands to your ears and say: "Allahu Akbar." This means: (Allah is the Greatest). This is called Takbiratul Ihram.

2. Now place your right hand on top of your left hand on the chest and look downward to the place where your forehead will touch the ground in the Sujood (prostration). Then, after this, recite SuratulFatihah (the opening chapter) of the Holy Quran: as shown below:

- "A'udhubillahiminashshaitanirrajim." This is called Ta'awwudh, and it means: "I seek shelter in Allah from the rejected Satan."

- Then recite: "Bismillahirrahmanirrahim." This is called Tasmiyah, and it means: "In the name of Allah, the most Gracious, the most Merciful."

- "Al hamdulillahirabbil 'alamin. Arrahmanirrahim. Maliki yawmiddin. Iyyakana'buduwaiyyakanasta'in. Ihdinassiratalmustaqim. Siratalladhinaan'amta'alaihim, ghairilmaghdubi'alaihimwa lad dhallin. (Amen)." This means: "All praises and thanks be to Allah, the Lord of the worlds, the most Gracious, the most Merciful; Master of the Day of Judgment. You alone we worship, from you alone we seek help. Guide us along the straight path - the path of those whom you favored, not of those who earned your anger or went astray."

3. Now recite any other passage from the Holy Quran. For example Suart Al Ikhlas "The Sincerity", as shown below:

"Bismillahirrahmanirrahim

Qulhuwallahuahad, allahussamad, lam yalidwa lam yulad, wa lam yakullahukufuwanahad."

This means:

"In the name of Allah, the most Gracious, the most Merciful. Say, He is Allah, the One. Allah is Eternal and Absolute. He begets not, nor was He begotten. And there is none co-equal unto Him."

4. Now bow down saying: "Allahu Akbar" and place your hands on your knees and say silently: "SubhanaRabbiyalAdhim." This means: (How Perfect is my Lord, the Supreme) three times. This position is called Rukoo'. Keep your head in line with your back, and look downward to the place of Sujood.

5. Stand up from the bowing position saying: "Sami'Allahulimanhamidah" (Allah hears those who praise Him)"Rabbanalakalhamd." This means: (Our Lord, praise be to You).

6. Prostrate on the floor saying: "Allahu Akbar" with your forehead, nose, palms of both hands, your knees, and toes all touching the floor. Then recite silently: "SubhanaRabbiyalA'la." (How Perfect is my Lord, the Highest) three times. This position is called Sujood. Keep your arms away from the sides of the body and the ground.

7. Sit up from the floor saying Allahu Akbar. Sit upright with your knees bent and palms placed on them and say: "Rabbighfir li." This means: "O my Lord! Forgive me." Say "Allahu Akbar".

8. Prostrate again in the Sujood position. Recite "SubhanaRabbiyalA'la" three times. Sit up from this position saying "Allahu Akbar".

9. This completes the first Rak'ah or unit of Salah. Now stand up for the second Rak'ah and perform it in the same way.

10. At the beginning, and after the second Sujood (prostration), you sit on the left leg while keeping the right foot upright and put your right hand on the right thigh, with all fingers together

in a fist except the index finger. Stick the index finger straight out. Put your left hand on the left

thigh. Now recite Tashahhud silently:

11. Now turn your face to the right saying: "Assalamualaikumwarahmatullah" (peace and the mercy of Allah be on you)

12. Then turn your face to the left saying: "Assalamualaikumwarahmatullah" (peace and the mercy of Allah be on you).

NUMBER OF RAK'AHS OF PRAYER

- 1. Al Fajr prayer is 2 rak'ahs.
- 2. Al Zuhr prayer is 4 rak'ahs.
- 3. Al Asr prayer is 4 rak'ahs.
- 4. Al Maghrib prayer is 3 rak'ahs.
- 5. Al Isha prayer is 4 rak'ahs.

How to be duly faithful?

- 1. Always tell the truth and never lie.
- 2. Always be honest and never betray.
- 3. Never steal but preserve the property of other people.
- 4. Keep ties with those who cut you off, and do good to those who harmed you, and speak

the truth even if it were against your own self.

- 5. Always show gratitude to your parents.
- 6. Always keep ties with your relatives.
- 7. Always perform the five prayers in their set times.
- 8. Always seek goodness for all people.
- 9. Never harm others.
- 10. Smile in the faces of people.
- 11. Turn a blind eye from the private parts of others.

The Prophet, peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, said: "By his good character a believer will attain the degree of one who prays during the night and fasts during the day."
