Making Ihrām form the Meeqāt.



Tawāf of Arrival for the Qārin and Mufrid pilgrims, and Tawāf of 'Umrah for the Mutamatti' pilgrim.



Sa'i of Hajj (between Safā and Marwah) for the Qārin and Mufrid pilgrims, and Sa'i of 'Umrah (between Safā and Marwah) for the Mutamatti' pilgrim.

The Mutamatti' pilgrim then exits the state of Ihrām after cutting his hair short.



Going to Minā on the 8th of Dthul-Hijjah and spending the night there.

The Mutamatti' pilgrim makes Ihrām for

Hajj on this day.





Standing at 'Arafah on the the 9th of Dthul-Hijjah until sunset.

The activities of the 10th of Dthul-Hijjah.





Spending the night before the dawn of the 10th of Dthul-Hijjah at Muzdalifah.

Shaving the head, or cutting the hair short.



Performing Tawāf of Ifādhah for everyone, then the Mutamatti' pilgrim is to perform Sa'i of Hajj (between Safā and Marwah).



Tawāf of Farewell (Tawāf ul-Wadā').



Spending the nights of Tashreeq in Minā (i.e. the nights before the dawn of 11th, 12th, and 13th of Dthul-Hijjah), and stoning each of the three Jamrāt after noon, each with seven pebbles.
